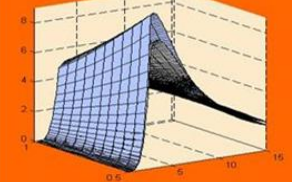

**Useful Information on Transportation**

- **Transportation from the Airport to Syntagma (City Center)**

I. By bus:

For Syntagma (City Center) you should take bus line **X95** from the Athens International Airport ‘Eleftherios Venizelos’. The bus departure from the area located at the inner curbside of the Arrivals Level, right outside the Intra Schengen area, between Doors 4-5 and reaches Syntagma Square.

***Estimated time: 60-70 min***

II. By metro:

You can take the metro from the airport\* with direction to ‘Monastiraki’ and you get off at ‘Syntagma’ Station.

*\* Note: In the airport, both metro and suburban railway departs from the same platform.*

***Estimated time: 45 min***

III. By suburban railway:

You can also use the suburban railway from the airport\* with direction to ‘Athens-Larissa Station’. You will get off at ‘Doukissis Plakentias’ Station. There you take line 3 of the metro, and you get off at ‘Syntagma’ Station.

*\* Note: In the airport, both metro and suburban railway departs from the same platform.*

***Estimated time: 45 min***

IV. By taxi:

Taxis are always available at the airport.

Transportation from the Airport to the centre of Athens should cost about **20-30 €** depending on the traffic.

### *Receipt*

According to Greek Legislation, taxi drivers should provide upon request a receipt for the amount paid for transportation services. The receipt should also indicate the taxi registration number and the driver's name.

### *Prebooked Taxis*

Prebooked taxis are provided upon request and make use of the inner curb of the Arrivals Level as a staging area.

### *Lost items in taxis*

In case of losing items in taxis, please contact, the radio taxi Service Company where taxis are registered or the central police switchboard at (+30) 210 6421616, and provide the taxi registration number and the driver's name.

***Estimated time: Depending on traffic***

## ■ **Transportation from Syntagma (City Center) to the Airport**

### I. By bus:

For the Athens International Airport, you can use the **X95** bus line which departures from Syntagma Square. This will take you directly to the airport.

***Estimated time: 60-70 min***

### II. By metro:

Take line 3 (**blue line**) of the metro from the 'Syntagma' Station with direction to the 'Airport'.

***Estimated time: 45 min***

### III. By suburban railway:

Take line 3 (**blue line**) of the metro from the 'Syntagma' Station with direction to 'Doukissis Plakentias'. There you change to suburban railway with direction to the 'Airport'.

***Estimated time: 45 min***

### IV. By taxi:

Taxis are always available at Syntagma Square. You will find a taxi rank right in front of Syntagma Square. Transportation to the airport will cost approximately **20-30 €** depending on the traffic.

***Estimated time: Depending on traffic***

### ■ Transportation from Syntagma (City Center) to the Port of Piraeus

#### I. By metro:

Take line 2 (**red line**) from 'Syntagma station' with direction to 'Aghios Antonios] and get off at 'Omonia station' where you change to line 1 (**green line**) with direction to 'Piraeus'. Piraeus is the last stop of line 1 and right across from Piraeus metro station you can see the port.

***Estimated time: 40 min***

#### II. By taxi:

There is a taxi rank right in front of Syntagma Square. Transportation to the port of Piraeus will cost around **10-15 €**

***Estimated time: Depending on traffic***

■ Transportation from the Port of Piraeus to Syntagma (City Center)

I. By metro:

Take line 1 (green line) from Piraeus with direction to ‘Kifissia’ or ‘Irimi’ and you get off at ‘Omonia station’ where you change to line 2 (red line) with direction to ‘Aghios Dimitrios’. You get off at ‘Syntagma’ Station.

***Estimated time: 40 min***

II. By taxi:

Taxis are available anytime outside the port. Transportation to the city center will cost around **10-15 €**

***Estimated time: Depending on traffic***
